

**NOTIFICATION OF CHILE OF ADJUSTED THRESHOLD VALUES UNDER
CHAPTER *Kbis* OF THE CANADA-CHILE FREE TRADE AGREEMENT**

December 28, 2021

In accordance with Annex *Kbis*-01.1-7 of the Canada-Chile Free Trade Agreement, Chile hereby notifies Canada of the newly calculated thresholds for Chile's procurement covered by Chapter *Kbis* of the Agreement, effective January 1, 2022:

- For central level entities listed in Annex *Kbis*-01.1-1, CLP\$ 63,740,967 (US\$ 83,099) for contracts for goods, services, or any combination thereof, and CLP\$ 5,364,815,495 (US\$ 6,994,102) for contracts for construction services.
- For other covered entities listed in Annex *Kbis*-01.1-2, CLP\$ 318,704,834 (US\$ 415,495) for contracts for goods, services or any combination thereof, and CLP\$ 10,199,044,843 (US\$ 13,296,479) for contracts for construction services.

The thresholds above were calculated in accordance with Annex 1001.1c of the North American Free Trade Agreement, except the threshold for construction services in Annex *Kbis*-01.1-1 which was calculated in accordance with the formula in the World Trade Organization Agreement on Government Procurement, GPA/1, Annex 3.

The next adjustment of the threshold values will be made in two years and will become effective on January 1, 2024.
